Application Checklist for New Applicants

Dear Parent:

Thank you for your recent inquiry regarding Kirk of the Hills Christian Day School. The application process is outlined below for your convenience.

1. ___ Fill out the **Application Form** completely (front & back). All information must be provided.
2. ___ Submit the **Application Form** along with a check for the amount of \$300.00 *per child*, before your student can be considered for enrollment.
3. ___ Applicants for Elementary grades (1-6) must sign the **Authorization for Release of Records** form and submit it to the office of your child's current school.
4. ___ Applicants for Jr. Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and Elementary classes must have the **Common Referral Form**, and its cover letter, to the student's current teacher to complete and send directly to the Kirk Day School.

When these steps have been completed, the Director of Admissions will contact you to make the following appointments:

1. ___ Enrollment Interview: Both parents meet with two Kirk of the Hills Christian Day School Board members.
2. ___ Screening Placement Test for applicants for Kindergarten through sixth grade.

Kirk Day School is a covenantal school and exists to assist Christian parents in the education of their children within the context of a Biblical worldview, in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. (Deuteronomy 6:6, 7) Our by-laws state that at least one parent must be a believer. Our purpose in the enrollment interview is to give you the opportunity to tell us your Christian Testimony. If you have never done this, you may want to take time to consider the following ideas before the interview:

- You may want to share a little general information about yourself. Everyone's conversion will be different. (For instance, some have been brought up in Christian homes, never knowing a time when they did not know the Lord, while others have come to know Christ at a later age.)
- What were the circumstances that the Lord used in your conversion?
- What are the changes that have taken place in your life as a result?
- On what do you depend for your salvation/relationship to Christ?
- What is the Lord doing in your life now?

We are thankful that you are considering The Kirk of the Hills Christian School. After the enrollment interview, you will receive a letter and/or phone call from the Director of Admissions letting you know the current status of your application for a place in our school.
